Liam is an economist, writer and broadcaster. He is a Governor of the John Lyon School and also an experienced business investor, having been a board member and partner of an international asset-management company working with leading pension funds, charities and sovereign wealth funds. A widely respected economics commentator, Liam has been a reporter for The Economist, The Financial Times and Channel Four News and is now best-known for his award-winning weekly *Economics Agenda* column in *The* Sunday Telegraph. Liam holds a First Class (Hons) degree in Economics from the University of Warwick and an MPhil (Econ) from St Antony's College, Oxford University. He joined John Lyon on a scholarship in 1980 and left in 1987 as Head Boy. He was the first person in his family to go to university.
